

PROTECH HOLD OPEN DAY

FOR CLIENTS, PARTNERS AND ASSOCIATIONS AT THE HURLINGHAM CLUB, LONDON ON TUESDAY 14TH OCTOBER 2008

There were over 70 attendees to the Open Day held at the Georgian Clubhouse within the magnificent grounds of The Hurlingham Club in South West London, with many ProTech clients being represented.

The Open Day enabled ProTech to present the next generation of the Pro product suite, Pro-8, and partners to present their latest product offerings.

The day began with a welcome, first from ProTech's Chairman Richard Couchman, and then from Jenny Mitchell of The Hurlingham Club.

Mark Trough, Managing Director, ProTech then presented the road map and strategy for Pro-8, covering why there was a new generation of product, the latest technologies ProTech were utilising for Pro-8, the approach ProTech were taking in building and strengthening partnerships, a summary of what Pro-8 would provide, and details of the 8.0 release.

A demonstration of Pro-8 software by Lee Cordell, Director of Development, followed, which showed the new user interface, the new features, and the integration with the latest Microsoft products including Office 2007, Workflow and InfoPath.

The partner presentations followed after a short break. The first presentation though was from John Brindley, Institute of Physics, who spoke about online communities, why IOP went online, IOP's recent implementation of the social networking solution from Small World Labs, and the positive member reaction. This was followed by a presentation from Andy Jones of Small World Labs.

Two presentations by Experian, a ProTech partner for more than ten years, followed. Chris Hay of Experian QAS presented the importance of contact data quality and the available QAS solutions. Gavin Lawrence of Experian Payments then presented the payment software solutions available to reduce payment errors bringing time and cost savings.
