



ProTech Launches Web-Based Record Management Software

ProTech's ProWeb module allows a user or end client to access all of the functionality of the suite in a setting familiar to a web viewer.

ProTech Computer Systems has launched ProWeb, a fully integrated web-based module which extends the functionality of its Pro-7 record management software for membership-based associations and charities.

ProWeb provides seamless integration between an organisation's website and the core business functions of Pro-7, enabling users to combine their central knowledge base with key functions such as membership registration and online payments. In the case of a charity, this web integration would allow the payment details of patrons and donors to be cross-referenced to existing records to provide insight into who is donating money and why.

ProWeb can help determine an organisation's customer base through external web use. It can also be used as a tool to combine information about membership, subscriptions, events and even web-site interaction with payment details to give charities the ability to keep patrons informed with targeted updates.

Mark Trough, Managing Director of ProTech Computer Systems, comments, "When designing ProWeb we wished to increase not only the ease with which external visitors could access the financial functions of a charity's website but also simplify the process of receiving donations and pledges for the charity."

He concludes, "The functionality of ProWeb also extends far beyond enabling the collection of online donations. For instance, colleges who use ProWeb can give their students secure access to their exam results online whilst also registering new students and collecting payment for courses. The software can record and collate all forms of data, from registration details to financial transactions, and store it in a central database and, provided you have access rights and an internet connection, can be viewed from any remote location. In this way, ProWeb allows for the two-way flow of information between

charity and patron, organisation and consumer, ultimately to benefit of everyone."

IMarEST (Institute of Marine Engineering, Science and Technology) is an early adopter of the ProWeb module. Jerry Frost, IT Manager for IMarEST, says, "For the Institute, the unique selling point of Pro-7 was the ProWeb module and the level of web integration that it could introduce to our business processes. For instance, we can now collect donations and registration fees from members over the internet whilst integrating the data they provide into our databases. We can then use this intelligence to inform our members with relevant communications."
